



# MULTIPACK ROBOT



Our multipack bag can be transparent because of the neat and aligned product presentation inside the bag. Illustrated is a multipack filled with multiple flow-wrapped single serving potato chips. A special feature we offer is very large multipacks. Flowpack must stop at 15 servings, we can go up to 80 with a higher and wider bag.

Multipack is a bagloading machine for so-called multipacks. Not only for pre-wrapped chips, also frozen food such as frozen croissants and pastry is popular. Loose buns too, toys, pre-wrapped tortillas, cloth, tissues etc. Multipack can be linked to a bag closing machine with optional heatseal-, clip or peelable closure.

## Highlights

- delicate products are not damaged as all handling is horizontal (no vertical drop of product as in vertical flowpacks)
- packs have square gusseted bottom fold, as preferred by supermarkets; square packs do not slide off store shelves, as usual pillow packs do
- handles bags with carrier grip and other features too
- no need for multihead weighers to drop-feed the machine. All feeding is horizontal and often manual.
- neat aligned product presentation, not random, so bags may be transparent.

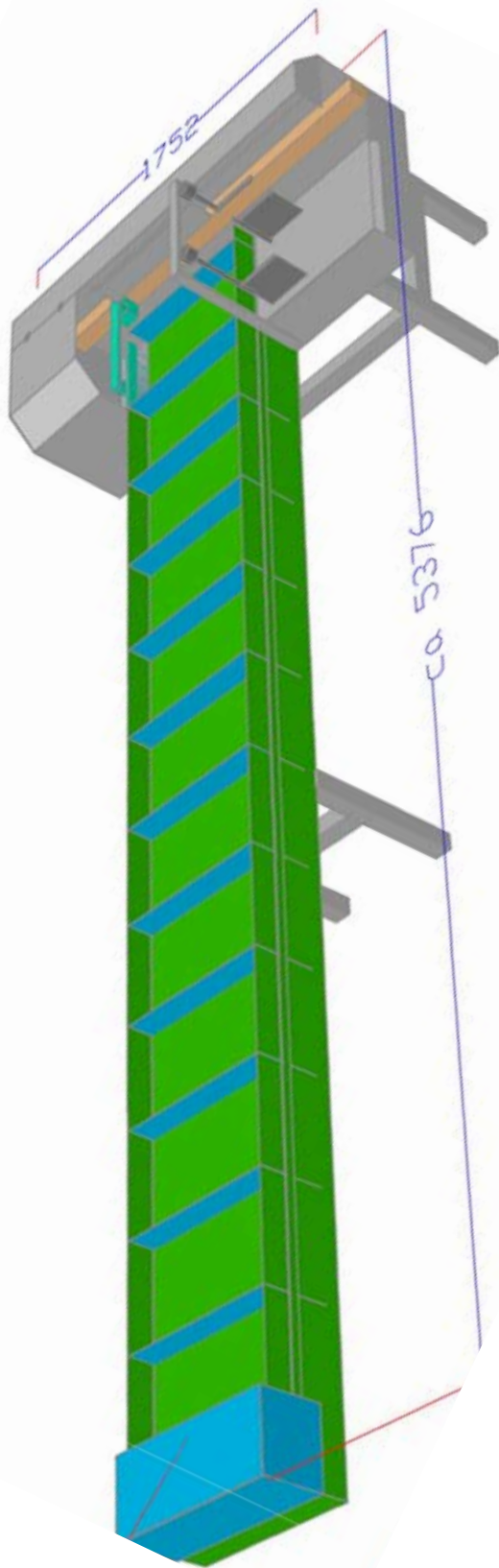

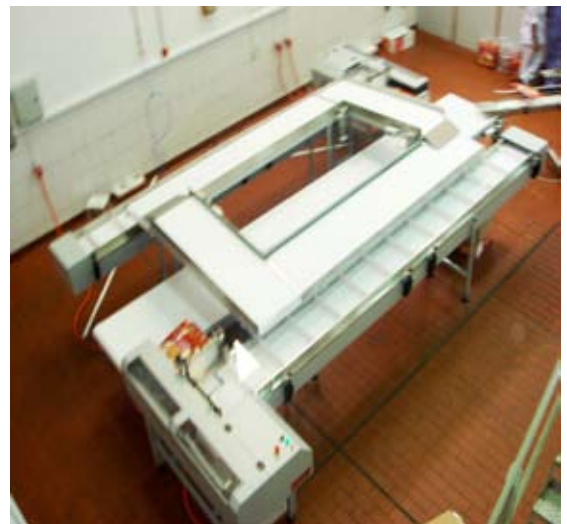
